

## **Course Description (INTERMEDIATE/SRO II):**

This forty-hour course was designed as a direct result of the expansion of school-based policing. The course was written and refined with input from law enforcement officers, school administrators, teachers, supervisors and school board members that are now influential in the field of school-based policing. The skills taught and the education that began in the Basic SRO Course will continue with this second block of instruction. While it is beneficial to have attended the basic course, it is not a requirement to be successful in this course. However, attendees that have not attended a basic SRO course should have experience in the school environment. Attendees will have the opportunity to share their problems, identify, and discuss possible solutions. They also will be taught ways to improve their performance and to enhance existing programs by developing new resources. Specialized programs in place across the country will be discussed to help attendees adapt and modify them to benefit their students, schools and communities.

Any School Resource Officer, School Administrator, School Liaison Officer, DARE Officer, School Peace Officer, School Security Personnel, Dean of Students, Teacher, Program Supervisor, Probation Officer or anyone interested in school safety and security will benefit from attending this course.
